

## Travel Tips for Getting to Zhuhai for RemaxWorld Expo 2023

**ATTENTION: The CKS ferry from Hong Kong Airport to Zhuhai is not available, please select other transportation.**

*\*Reminder: to avoid frustration, please prepare local currency and change when arriving in different cities. All passengers should prepare local currencies in advance:*

- *Guangzhou: please prepare Chinese Yuan (Renminbi);*
- *Hong Kong: please prepare Hong Kong dollars;*
- *Macao, please prepare Macao patacas.*

*Please note that official currencies are used in each respective region, and it is recommended to have local currency on hand for your convenience when travelling and during your stay.*

	Tickets: Gate 17 at the second floor of Ground Traffic Center (GTC) in Terminal 3

<b>Bus</b>	Route: take Bus Line AP1 to Zhuhai Gongbei Port → clear Macao immigration → walk across to the Zhuhai border → go through China Mainland immigration and customs
	Travelling time: about 40 minutes depending on crowds
	Operating time: 6:00 - 01:20
	Ticket price: MOP6 (USD1) per person
<i>Hint: Please prepare local cash and coins in advance to avoid frustration</i>	

## From Hong Kong International Airport

<b>HK-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Shuttle Bus</b> <span style="background-color: yellow;">(recommended option)</span>	<p><i>*Clear Immigration and Customs first and collect your luggage. You will need to take two shuttle buses to reach Zhuhai.</i></p> <p>Route: Take bus No. A29 from HKIA Ground Transportation Center to HZMB Passenger Clearance Building → go through immigration (leaving Hong Kong) → take the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Shuttle Bus to Zhuhai Port → go through Mainland China immigration and customs</p>
	<p>Travelling time: 50 minutes in total</p>
	<p>Operating time: 24 hours a day</p>

## Getting to Zhuhai: what are the best options?

*RT Media* Director, David Gibbons, offers some suggestions:

You now have more options to reach Zhuhai after landing in Hong Kong. You can still catch a train and then a ferry from downtown Hong Kong (a long trip). But the quicker, cheaper route is the new Hong Kong-Macau/Zhuhai Sea bridge. There are two options if you choose to use the sea bridge: a VIP Ride Share (my preferred option) or public shuttle buses (which is more awkward).

### Pre-Travel Tips:

### Prepare some cash:

1. If you are travelling through Hong Kong, have some small currency HK dollars with you.
2. For example, you will need HK\$10 to catch the B4 bus from Hong Kong Airport to the Hong Kong-Macau-Zhuhai-Bridge Border, for example, and no change is given. Credit cards are not accepted either.
3. There is a TRAVELEX booth in the Arrivals area of HK Airport (see photo) that can exchange US dollars, Euros and Chinese RMB on the spot.
4. Arriving in mainland China with some RMB is also helpful, especially if you do not have cash in the WeChat App wallet. 200RMB (about US\$30) will be sufficient for taxis etc.
5. Apart from your hotel, you will most likely not be able to use credit cards in China, including buses, taxis, supermarkets etc.



	<p><b>Prepare the name and address of your hotel in Chinese:</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ask your hotel to send the name and address to you in Chinese.</li> <li>2. Show this hardcopy or digital copy (on your phone) to your taxi driver to help avoid confusion and get you to the right place.</li> </ol>
	<p><b>Load WeChat onto your mobile device</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Have it operational before you leave home;</li> <li>2. Use it to declare your health status as you go through any Mainland border crossings to enter China (Zhuhai, Guangzhou, Shanghai etc)  This CHINA CUSTOMS Mini Program (within WeChat) is in English. Download it here within WeChat: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Cut and paste this text into the SEARCH bar at the top of the screen:  #小程序://CustomsPocketDeclaration/1kH5TEADHnNIsMx</li> <li>b. Go to MINI PROGRAMS</li> <li>c. Download the CHINA CUSTOMS mini program ready for your border crossing;</li> <li>d. If all the above fails, simply ask the staff at the health declaration desk to help you as you enter the customs and immigration hall.</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. WeChat is an effective tool to engage with your suppliers even after you return home: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. it can translate signs and text into your own language;</li> <li>b. it has a wallet to store money for easy transactions in supermarkets, taxis, street vendors etc.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>



Hong Kong International Airport to Zhuhai Border		
	(My preferred option) VIP Ride Share Van	Public Shuttle Buses
<b>Regularity:</b>	Every 10-20 minutes	Every 30-60 minutes, 24 hours a day
<b>Cost:</b>	HK\$200 (US\$30) including luggage. Major credit cards or cash accepted.	Bus 1: Route B4 - HK\$9 (about US\$1.50) You can only use Hong Kong dollars and place the notes into the deposit box next to the driver. No change is given. Bus 2: Route HMZB - RMB 65 (about US\$10) plus additional RMB 65 for each additional suitcase. Cash accepted.
<b>Travelling time:</b>	40 minutes	90+ minutes
<b>Steps:</b>	After disembarking your plane: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• fill in your Hong Kong Arrival form</li> <li>• keep the second page (Hong Kong Departure form)</li> <li>• clear immigration and collect your bags.</li> </ul>	

- Go to the KCTIL booth in the Arrivals Hall of HK International Airport.
- It is situated at the far-left end of the hall as you leave customs and immigration (see photos).
- Clearly request Zhuhai. You can use your credit card to purchase a VIP seat all the way to the Zhuhai border over the new Hong Kong – Macau-Zhuhai Bridge (HMZB).



- You and your luggage will be taken to the vehicle in the neighboring car park.

- Take the elevator down to the street level.
- Look for and wait at the B4 Bus station (pictured).
- pay HKD10 into the collection box next to the driver.
- Make sure you and your luggage is secure as the bus twists and turns regularly on the road.
- The trip takes about 10-15 minutes



- The bus will take you to the Hong Kong-Macau-Zhuhai Bridge (HMZB) Immigration (departure) terminal.





- You will not leave the vehicle—the driver will help you process your immigration from the vehicle.



- You will travel for 35 minutes across the bridge until you reach the China border where you will enter customs and immigration.

- Clearing immigration.
- Purchase tickets for the HMZB bus.
- Follow the signs to catch this public bus to the Zhuhai border.



- You will travel for 50 minutes across the bridge until you reach the China border where you will enter customs and immigration.

When you arrive at the Zhuhai (China Mainland) border you will need to:

- declare your health status on the WeChat App (see above) or ask staff for help.
- fill in the arrival card, show your passport and visa, and get photographed and fingerprinted.

**IMPORTANT NOTE**

Please abide by the Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China and other laws and regulations, and read the following information carefully.

1. For foreigners who reside or stay in domiciles other than hotels, they or the persons who accommodate them shall, within 24 hours after the foreigners' arrival at the accommodation, go through the registration formalities with the public security organs in the places of residence.
2. Foreigners holding Visas Z, X1, J1, Q1 or S1, shall apply for residence permits within 30 days after entry with the exit and entry administration authority of the public security organ in the proposed places of residence.
3. Foreigners who work in China shall obtain work permits and work-type residence permits.
4. Foreigners having reached the age of 16 who stay or reside in China shall carry with them passports or other international travel documents, or foreigners' stay or residence permits, and accept the inspection of public security organs.
5. Foreigners in China shall leave the country prior to the expiry of the prescribed duration of stay or residence. If they need to continue to stay or reside in China after the expiration, they shall apply for an extension of the duration of stay or residence.
6. Foreign Permanent Resident ID Card can be used alone as identity document within Chinese mainland.
7. Foreigners violating exit-entry administration laws and regulations may be detained, ordered to exit the country within a time limit, repatriated or denied entry into China etc.
